## Notes from the Prineipal by Mr. Theobald

Contact Information. Communication is vital to the success of any organization. As we look at moving into second semester, we ask that if any contact information for your student(s) has changed, that you please notify the office of those changes. It really puts the school in a precarious situation when a cell phone number has changed or a voice mailbox is either full or not set up, and we need to get in touch with a parent or guardian. This becomes really critical if an emergency situation arises. Thank you in advance for taking the time to update us on your contact information changes.

Illnesses. In looking back at the last part of first semester, the month of December was especially full of student illnesses. As a friendly reminder, students must leave school if they have a temperature of
 100.0 degrees or higher, diarrhea, communicable diseases or they are vomiting. Students who leave because of a fever are always a tricky situation, but the protocol is that students who leave with a fever must not return any sooner than 24 hours after the fever has subsided without the aid of any fever reducing medication. We also understand that fevers may come and go, but following this procedure is the best way to ensure that we are doing our best to manage the health and well being of all students at Sterling.
Absences. As we start the second semester, I just wanted to remind parents that students are allowed to miss 7 days per semester without a note from a doctor. If a student misses more than 7 days, they have the option to make up that time or forfeit credit. Our students and attendance was very good for the first semester, and I am hoping that the second semester will be even better.
